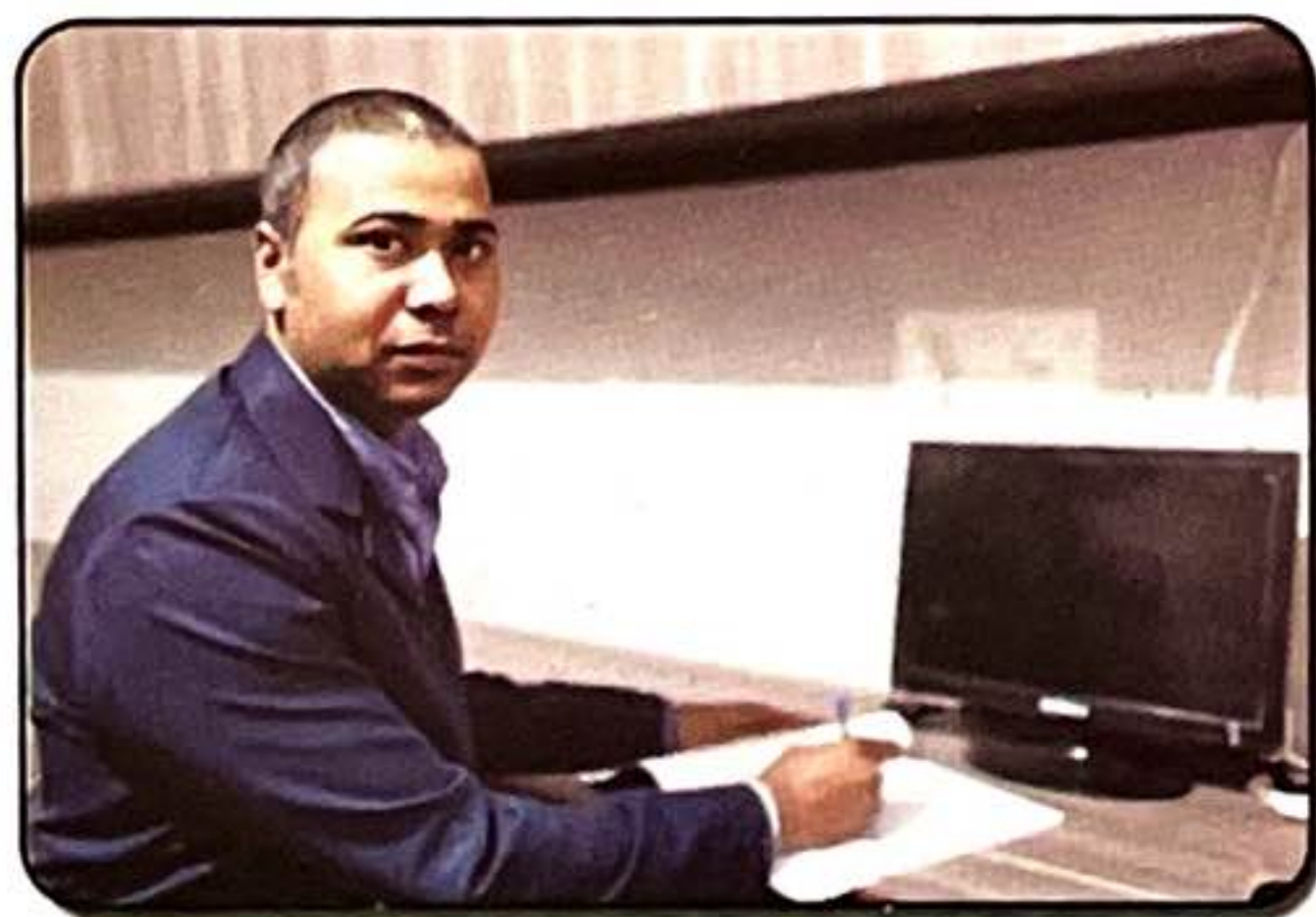

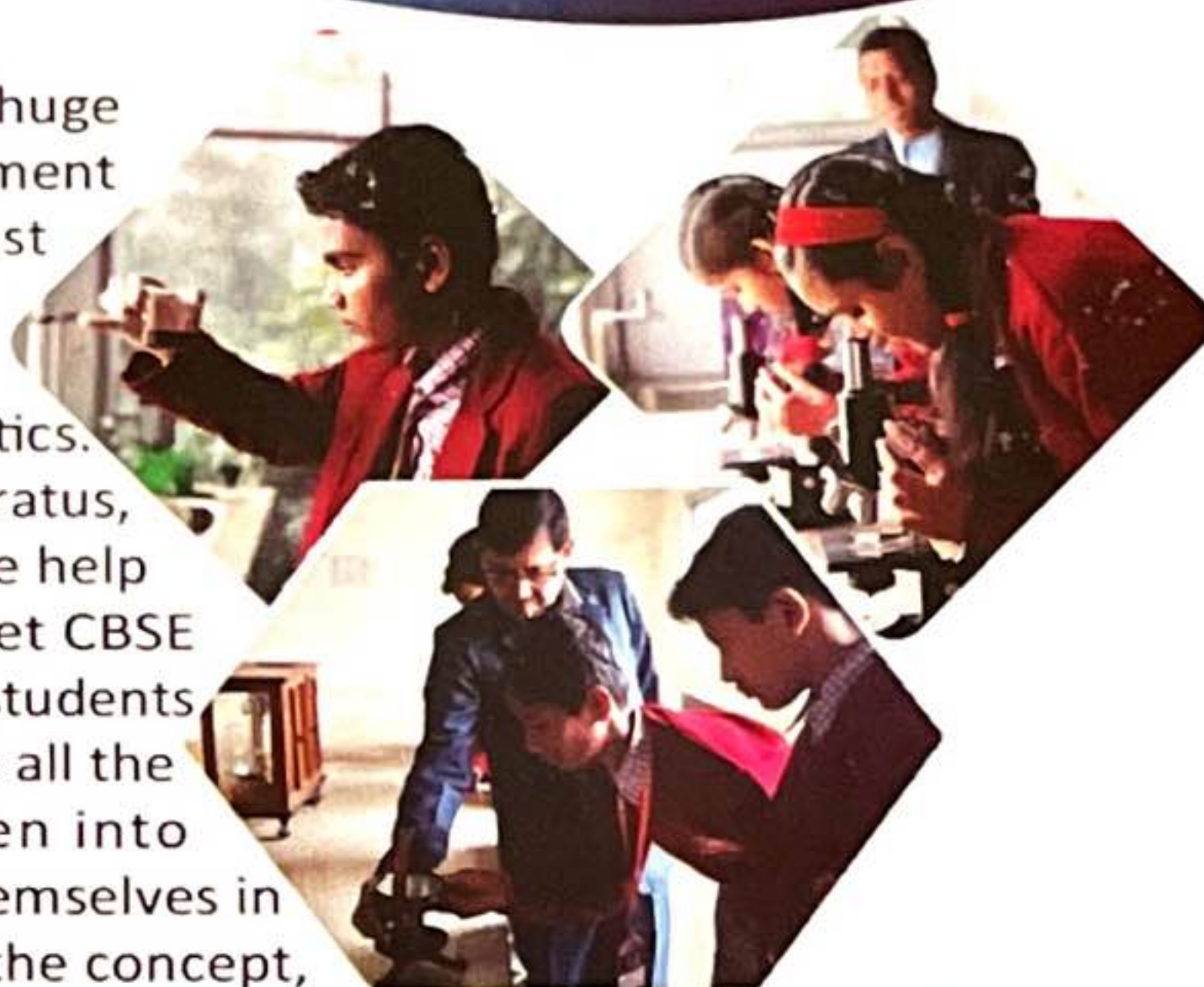
Facilities Provided by us:

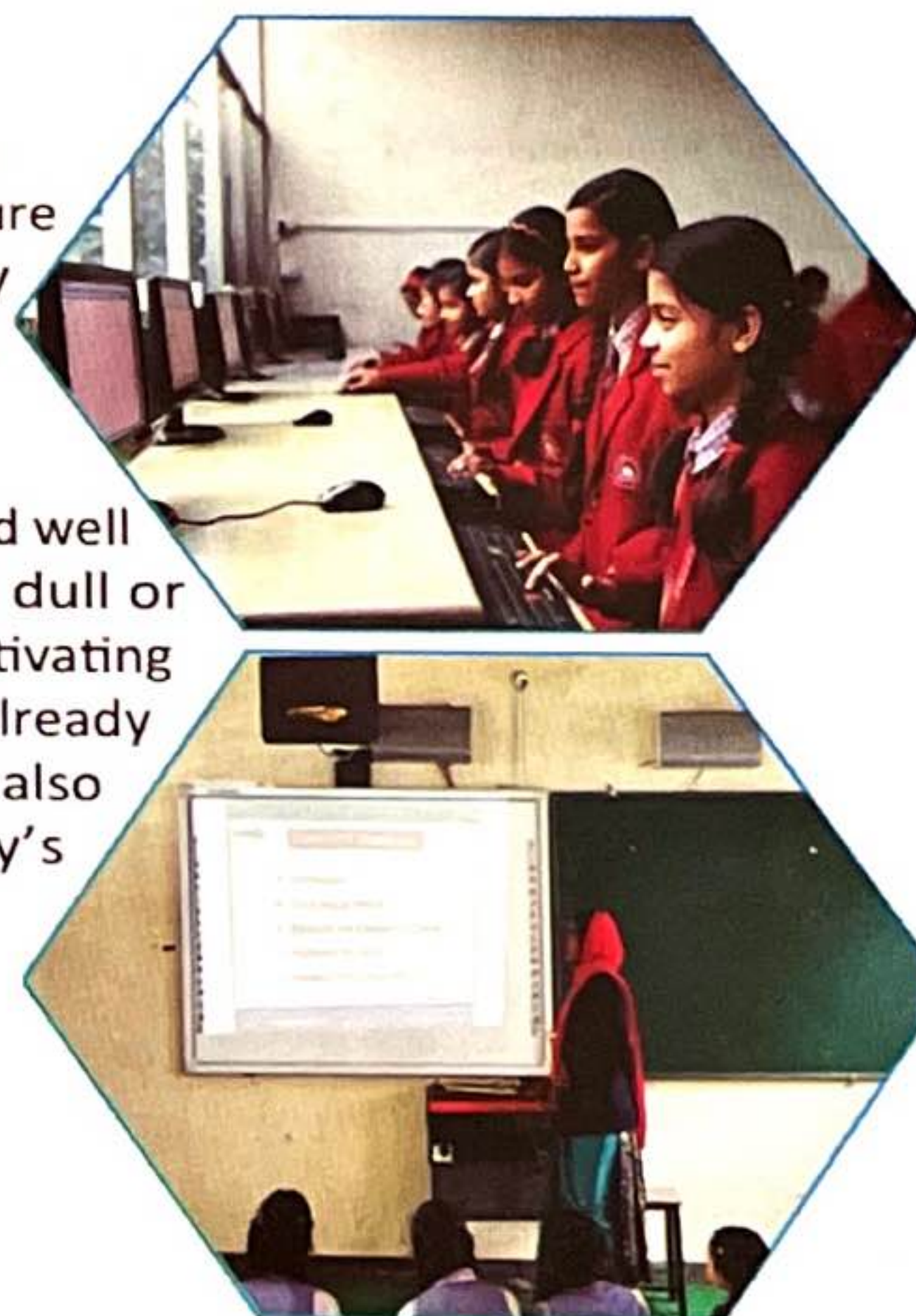
R.O.S. strongly believes that students must understand the practical importance of the theories, and develop a keen interest in researching and digging out the deeper insights further.

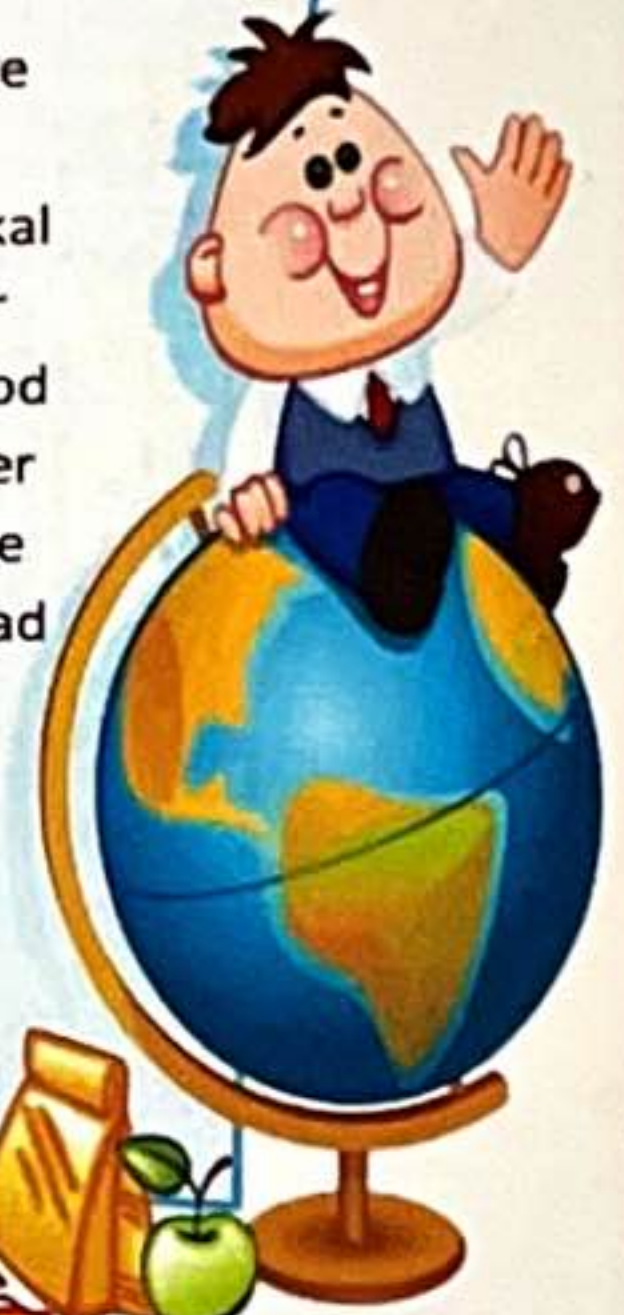

Please convey my regards to sister Geometry and reply soon. Rest is ok.

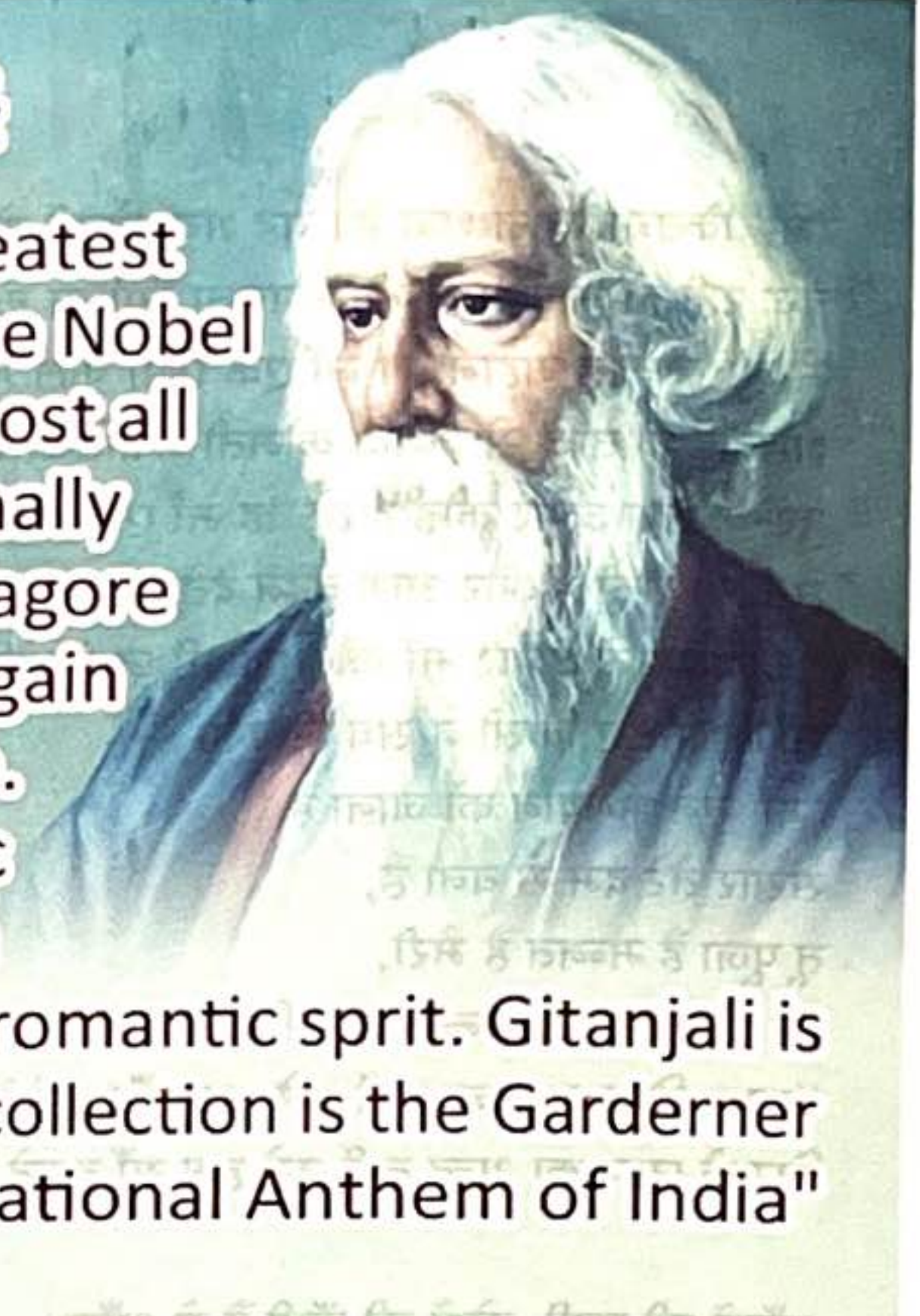

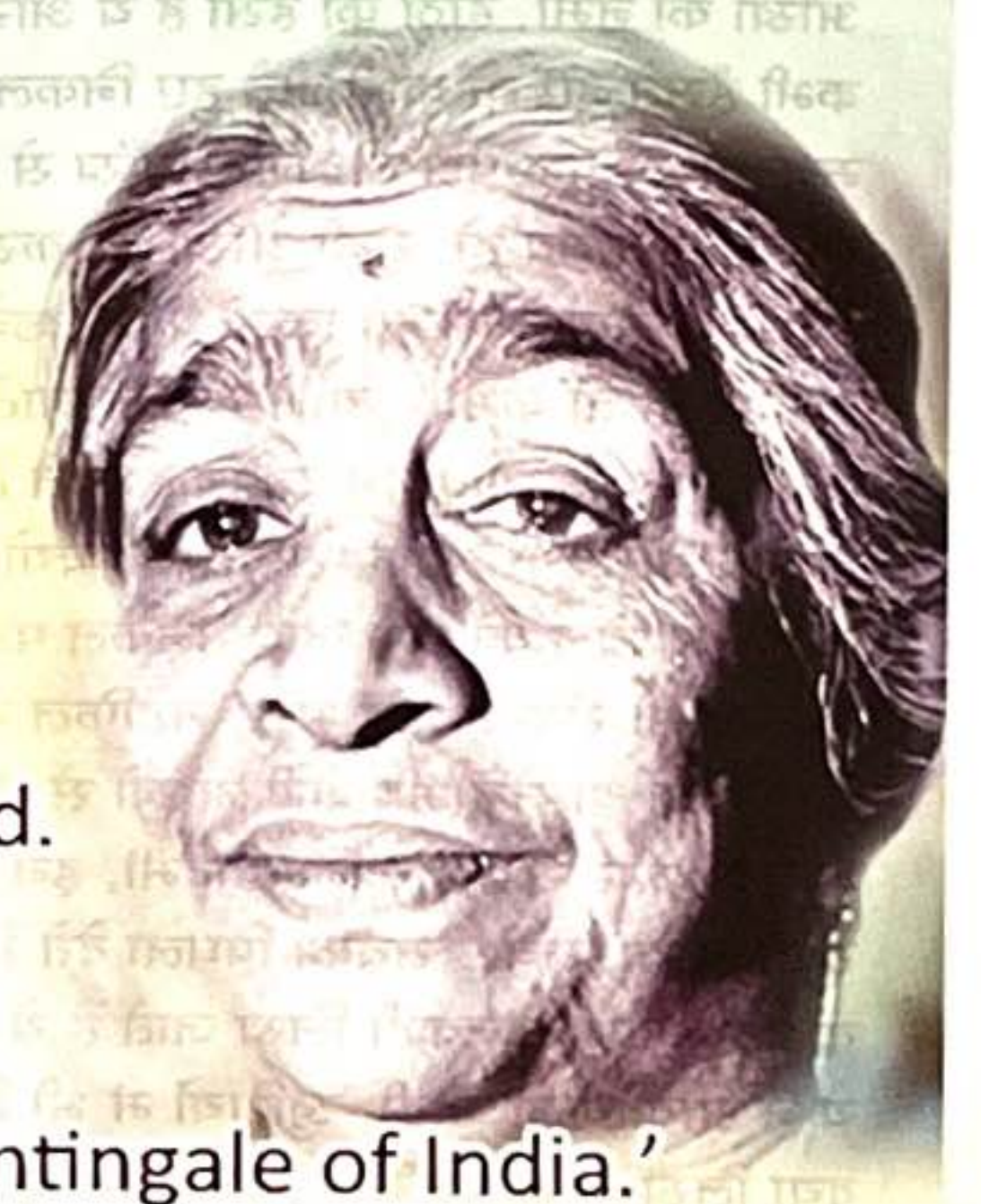
Rabindra Nath Tagore

Rabindra Nath Tagore (1861-1941) was one of the greatest writers in the history of Indian literature. He won The Nobel Prize for the literature in 1913. Though he wrote almost all literature genres, it is as a poet, he was internationally recognized. The Irish poet, W.B. Yeats introduced Tagore to the Western world. Tagore was the first Indian poet to gain a permanent place in the Canon of world literature. His poems express intense romantic and mystic sensibilities and can be compared to those of William Wordsworth and William Blake for their mystic and romantic spirit. Gitanjali is considered as his masterpiece and his most famous collection is the Gardener's Fruit, Gathering, and other poems. He wrote "The National Anthem of India" in Hindi called Jan Gana Mana.



Sarojini Naidu

Sarojini Naidu (1879-1949) was one of the Indian's most famous poets. Her work is noted for its expression of various shades of romantic sensibilities and fervor. Her poems combine elements of Indian culture and civilization, serving as a mirror to the time in which she lived. The major themes of Sarojini Naidu's poems are search for pure love, seeking comfort in natural beauty, and everyday experience of life. She was known as 'The Nightingale of India.'



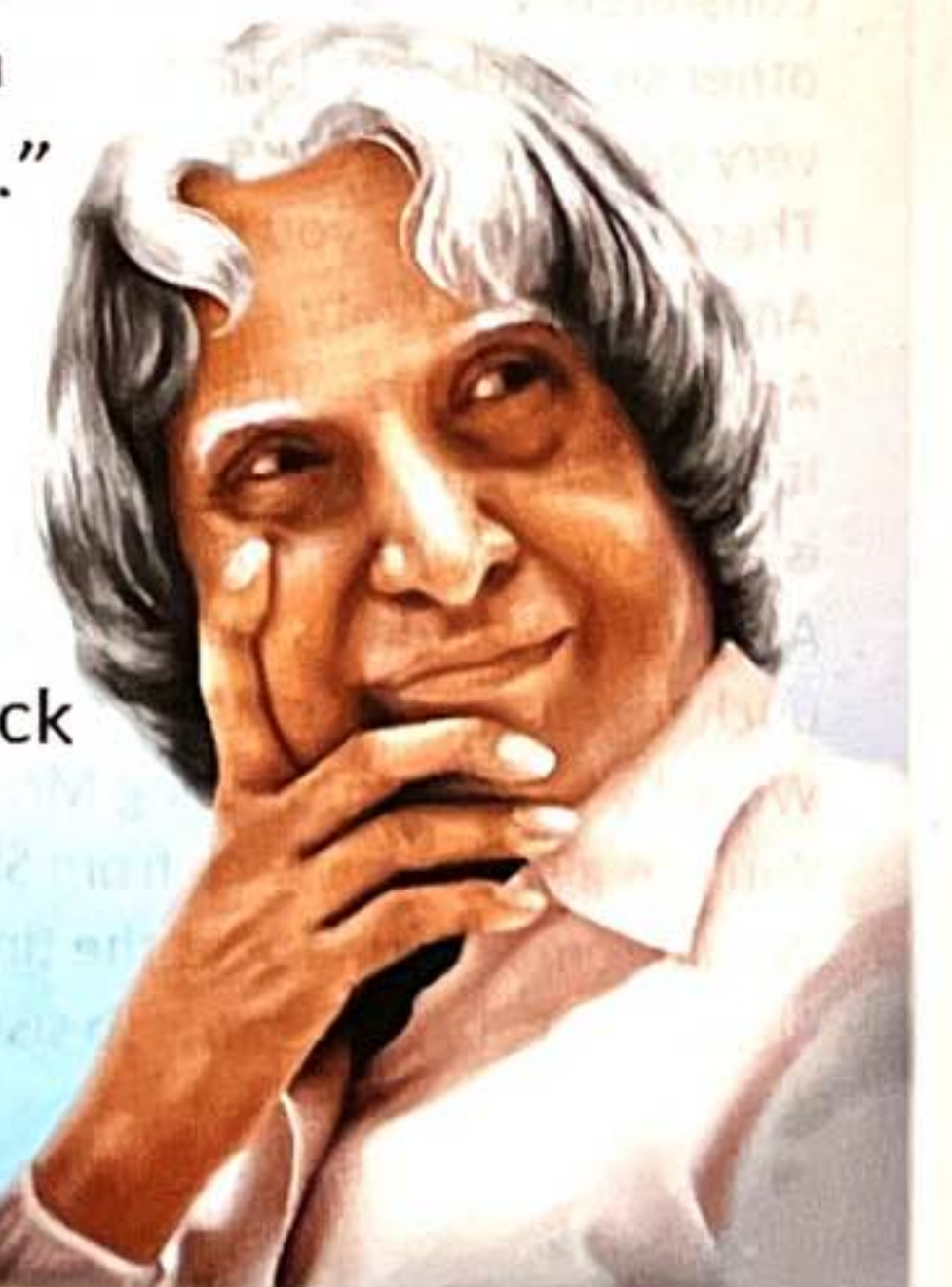

भारत कि प्रमुख कवयित्रियों में से एक कवयित्री है महादेवी वर्मा आधुनिक हिन्दी की सबसे सशक्त कवयित्रियों में से एक होने के कारण उन्हें आधुनिक मीरा के भी नाम से जाना जाता है। कवि निराला ने उन्हें 'हिन्दी के विशाल मंदिर की सरस्वती भी कहा है। महादेवी वर्मा ने स्वतंत्रता से पहले का भारत भी देखा और उसके बाद का भी। वे उन कवियों में से एक है जिन्होंने व्यापक समाज में काम करते हुए भारत के भीतर विध्यमान हाहाकार, रुदन को देखा, परखा और करुण होकर अन्धकार को दूर करने वाली दृष्टि देने की कोशिश की। इनका जन्म 26 मार्च 1907 ई0 में फरुखाबाद, उत्तरप्रदेश राज्य में हुआ था। इन्होंने संस्कृत तथा बंगला शब्दों को चुनकर हिन्दी का जाना पहनाया। इन्हें जानवरों तथा बच्चों के लोकप्रिय विषय में लिखना सबसे ज्यादा पसंद था। इनकी मृत्यु 11 सितंबर 1987 इलाहाबाद जिले में हुआ था। आज भी महादेवी वर्मा भारतवर्ष कि महान कवयित्री के नाम से जानी जाती हैं।
